Learning

Hopefully, all of you were able to access the learning lessons that our teacher's placed online yesterday. We believe that the lessons that we have provided - and that will be provided every Wednesday - will engage our students and make it possible for them to remain connected to their learning over the course of this closure period.

School days

The legislature adjourned on Tuesday, March 17, until, at the earliest, March 25 without any action on whether the school closure days will be forgiven. So at this point it will be the middle of next week at the earliest before we have any indication of what may happen with these days.

Starting school again

We are still planning on opening school again on April 13. No additional guidance has been given at this time. When we receive further guidance we will let everyone know.

Testing

The Michigan testing window begins April 13. The high school assessment is scheduled to begin April 14. The Michigan Department of Education has asked for a waiver from the federal government. The federal Department of Education has indicated that they are working on it but no decision has been made yet.

Food for families

The Novi Community School District is providing food every Tuesday for families. Families can pick up a seven day supply of breakfast and lunch for every child in their household. We are distributing at Novi High School. We also are running a bus to two neighborhood locations.
