Our Continuity of Learning Plan was approved by Oakland Schools Thursday. Phase 2 of our online learning experiences for students will begin on Monday, April 20. Each level, K-4, 5-6, 7-8, and 9-12, will have its own roadmap. A summary and directions will be posted on our district website. We will continue to use SeeSaw and Clever for grades K-6 and Schoology for grades 7-12.

Our new roadmap will feature teacher/student interaction, new content, and increased expectations for students. Our teachers and administrators have worked hard to create meaningful and appropriate online learning experiences for our students.

Our <u>Frequently Asked Questions page</u> continues to be updated. We appreciate all of your questions and concerns that you have submitted to us. We are trying to provide accurate and timely information. At times, we do not know the answers or the answers may change, so thank you for your patience as we work through the many challenges that we face together.

In the past, students were required to get a counselor's signature before enrolling in our high school summer school program. For this year's summer school, Novi students (in district) do not need to obtain a counselor form with a signature in order to register for summer school.

In the past, we have not had a middle school summer school program. Some parents have asked us if we will this year. We are examining that option and hope to have an answer shortly.

The school calendar has not yet been finalized for next year. However, we do know that the first day of school will be Tuesday, September 8.

Remember our Food Service program continues to run every Tuesday. Food pickup is in the high school Taft Rd. (bus loop) parking lot from 9:00 AM - 1:00 PM.
